Commercial Closet Association's Corporate Visionary Honors**

Event Also Marks Commercial Closet Association's Fifth Anniversary

November 21, 2006 - New York, NY – Commercial Closet Association's Second Annual Corporate Visionary Honors recognized MTV Networks and online travel company Orbitz.com for inclusive excellence in portrayals of lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender (LGBT) individuals in their promotional advertising. The ceremony took place on Monday, November 20, 2006 and was hosted by *The New York Times* as one of the last events held in their historic, 93-year-old building.
